	<p>Comment: Appellant, Robert M. Mumma, II, filed a notice of appeal from the January 31, 2017 order imposing sanctions against him for the legal fees incurred by appellee, Lisa Morgan, in connection with appellant's prior petition to remove her as co-executrix of the estate. It appears the estate remains under administration, and there is no apparent indication that the subject order is appealable pursuant to any subsection of Pa.R.A.P. 342. In his docketing statement, appellant asserts the January 31, 2017 order is appealable pursuant to Pa.R.A.P. 313. Appellant's brief does not address the jurisdictional grounds for this appeal.</p> <p>An appeal may be taken as of right from an order that is separable from and collateral to the main cause of action, where the right involved is too important to be denied review, and where the question presented is such that if review is postponed until final judgment, the claim will be irreparably lost. Pa.R.A.P. 313(b). All three prongs of Rule 313 must be clearly present for an order to qualify as a collateral order. <i>Rae v. Pennsylvania Funeral Directors Association</i>, 977 A.2d 1121, 1126 (Pa. 2009). Appellant is hereby directed to show cause, within ten days of the date of this order, as to why this appeal should not be quashed as having been taken from an order that is interlocutory and not appealable. Specifically, if appellant contends that Pa.R.A.P. 313 provides the jurisdictional basis for this appeal, appellant shall explain why the January 31, 2017 order satisfies the requirements of Pa.R.A.P. 313(b). Failure to respond to this directive may result in quashal of this appeal without further notice.</p>

	Comment: Appellant, Robert M. Mumma, II, filed a notice of appeal from the January 31, 2017 order imposing sanctions against him for the legal fees incurred by appellee, Lisa Morgan, in connection with appellant's prior petition to remove her as co-executrix of the estate. In his docketing statement, appellant asserted the January 31, 2017 order is appealable pursuant to Pa.R.A.P. 313. Since appellant's brief does not address the jurisdictional grounds for this appeal, by order of July 27, 2017, appellant was directed to show cause as to why this appeal should not be quashed as having been taken from an order that is interlocutory and not appealable. Appellant filed a response arguing why the subject order is appealable pursuant to Pa.R.A.P. 313. The Court will take no action at this time but will refer the issue of appealability to the merits panel. The July 27, 2017 show cause order is discharged. The merits panel may revisit the issue and may find that the appeal is defective. Therefore, appellant should be prepared to address the issue at oral argument if the panel or one of the parties raises the issue at that time, or in his brief if the case is to be submitted on briefs.
