Comment: NOW, November 3, 2022, upon consideration of the Respondent/Appellant's (Secretary) Emergency Application to Compel the Depositions of Commissioners Stuart L. Ulsh, Randy H. Bunch, and Paula J. Shives on November 4 and 5, 2022 (Application to Compel), which the Special Master considers together with Petitioners/Appellees' (collectively, Fulton County) Emergency Application for a Preliminary Injunction to Enjoin Discovery in Special Master Proceedings and to Compel Legal Rulings Preceding Said Discovery (Emergency Application), and in light of the Supreme Court's Order of November 2, 2022, referring the Emergency Application to the undersigned Special Master, the Special Master hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Given the current schedule, the Special Master will not order Stuart L. Ulsh, Randy H. Bunch, and/or Paula J.

To the extent the Emergency Application requests a stay of discovery and/or hearing pending a determination by the Special Master as to whether the instant contempt proceedings are civil or criminal in nature, the Special Master observes that, on the record at the October 27, 2022 status conference in this matter, the Special Master stated that it appeared from the parties filings that these proceedings are in the nature of civil, not criminal, contempt. In response, all parties agreed that these proceedings are in the nature of civil, not criminal, contempt. The Special Master hereby incorporates by reference in this Order a determination, as agreed by the parties, that the instant contempt proceedings are in the nature of civil contempt. The Special Master has afforded, and will continue to afford, the parties the level of due process that accords with that determination.
- 3. Comment: NOW, November 4, 2022, following a status conference, and upon consideration of Petitioners/Appellees' (collectively, Fulton County) Motion for Predicate Legal Rulings and to Exclude Certain Discovery Requested by the Secretary (Motion for Rulings), and Respondent/Appellant's (Secretary) Application for Discovery Sanctions and Incorporated Memorandum of Law (Application for Discovery Sanctions), the Special Master hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. To the extent the Motion for Rulings requests any relief on the basis that there is no factual issue in the instant contempt proceedings that requires discovery, such requests for relief are DENIED. The Special Master concludes that there are factual issues relevant to contempt that warrant discovery to facilitate development of an evidentiary record, as directed in our Supreme Court's October 21, 2022, and November 2, 2022 orders.
- 2. To the extent the Motion for Rulings requests any relief on the basis that conducting discovery before resolution of certain legal issues will unduly prejudice Fulton County, such requests for relief are DENIED. Further, the Special Master specifically concludes as follows:
- (i) The underlying litigation in the matter docketed at No. 277 M.D. 2021 in this Court does not preclude any discovery sought by the Secretary, as Fulton County has not properly shown or proven that a privilege or objection arises simply on the basis of the underlying litigation. Fulton County has not cited, and the Special Master's independent research has not disclosed, any authority to that effect. Accordingly, Fulton County has failed to raise a proper objection on this basis.
- (ii) Neither Fulton County's breach of contract action against Intervenor Dominion Voting Systems, Inc. (Dominion), as identified and described in the Motion for Rulings (Breach of Contract Action), nor any other litigation between Fulton County and Dominion, precludes any discovery sought by the Secretary. Fulton County has not properly shown or proven that a privilege or objection arises simply on the basis of other existing litigation. Fulton County has not cited, and the Special Master's independent research has not disclosed, any authority to that effect. The existence of other litigation alone does not
- basis. (iii) Dominion's proceeding against Fulton County pursuant to the Right-to-Know Law (RTKL), as such

shield a party from discovery. Accordingly, Fulton County has failed to raise a proper objection on this

- described in the Motion for Rulings, does not affect discovery in this contempt proceeding. Further, any rights or protections that Fulton County may generally have under the RTKL are not at issue in this proceeding and do not preclude any discovery sought by the Secretary. interrogatories, requests for admissions, and requests for production (collectively, the Secretary's Discovery), Fulton County failed to object in accordance with the Special Master's Rule to Show Cause and subsequent orders. Specifically, Fulton County failed to object to the Secretary's proposed deposition questions and has continued to raise only blanket objections to the Secretary's Discovery, as reiterated in its Motion for Rulings, in direct violation of Paragraph 5(d)(i) of the Rule to Show Cause. Fulton County has not, at any time,

availed itself of the opportunity to raise any objections to discovery on a specific, question-by-question basis as directed in the Special Master's orders. This has precluded the Special Master from making any meaningful determinations on Fulton County's claims of privilege. It is black letter law that the objector to a discovery request must demonstrate non-discoverability. Ario v. Deloitte & Touche LLP, 934 A.2d 1290, 1292-93 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2007) (citing 6 Stnd. Pa. Prac. § 34:24.) Fulton County has failed to carry its burden, and therefore its blanket claims of privilege are OVERRULED based on Fulton County's failure to assert them with sufficient specificity. This includes, without limitation, the claims based on attorney client privilege, the work product doctrine, the deliberative process privilege, and the asserted violation of the individual constitutional rights of Commissioners Stuart L. Ulsh, Randy H. Bunch, and/or Paula J. Shives

(collectively, the Commissioners) or of other unspecified persons from whom discovery is or may be sought.

- 4. To the extent the Motion for Rulings requests any relief based on an argument that the Secretary's Discovery will unduly favor Dominion's interest in this or other litigation, aid another private party, or "tilt the scales of justice," such requests for relief are DENIED based on the Special Master's ongoing obligation to afford due process and consider all parties' claims impartially, fairly, and
- accurately. The Special Master is, has been, and will continue to afford all parties due process, and Fulton County's conclusory claims to the contrary lacks merit.
- 5. In accordance with Paragraph 1 of the Special Master's November 3, 2022 Order, wherein the Special Master indicated she will consider whether to compel the Commissioners to attend depositions, and to the extent the Secretary wishes to continue with said depositions, the Special Master hereby compels Fulton County to make the Commissioners available for deposition on November 7,

and/or 8, 2022. No later than November 5, 2022, at 5:00 p.m., the Secretary shall serve Notices of Deposition on

the Commissioners indicating which of the above dates said depositions shall take place.

6. The Secretary's Application for Discovery Sanctions is held in abeyance pending the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing.

Comment: NOW, November 8, 2022, upon consideration of the unverified "Fulton County's Motion and/or Reply to Secretary's Motion and to Suspend Proceedings Against County Commissioners During Election Under Pennsylvania Law and to Stay Pending Application for Injunction in the Supreme Court" (Motion) filed by Petitioners/Appellees (collectively, Fulton County), the Motion is DENIED.

The Special Master has endeavored to provide every opportunity to Stuart L. Ulsh, Randy H. Bunch, and Paula J. Shives (collectively, the

Commissioners) to perform their official obligations as Commissioners, while also fulfilling their responsibilities in these contempt proceedings consistent with the Pennsylvania Supreme Court's Orders of October 21, 2022, and November 2, 2022,

which directed the Special Master to develop an evidentiary record and make a recommendation as part of her report to be filed in the Supreme Court no later than November 18, 2022. At a status conference on October 27, 2022, the Special Master proposed November 4, 2022, as a beginning date for the necessary evidentiary hearing. In response, Mr. Thomas J. Carroll, Esq. (Attorney Carroll) stated on the record that he would be completely unavailable for a hearing through November 4, 2022 due to a previously scheduled vacation, and he proposed that the hearing be scheduled for November 9, 2022, instead. Despite Respondent/Appellant's (the

Secretary) statement on the record that scheduling the hearing during the week of the Midterm Election would be inconvenient for her, the Special Master adopted Mr. Carroll's suggestion and scheduled the hearing for November 9, 2022. Additionally,

following the October 27, 2022 status conference, the parties were directed to file proposed scheduling orders regarding pre-hearing discovery. In Fulton County's proposal, Attorney Carrol specifically stated: "None of the parties has a professional

conflict on November 7th and 8th. The parties can vote by mail and conclude depositions in advance of the court's hearing that is scheduled for November 9th and November 10th." See Separate Discovery Proposal and Request for Briefing on

Motions Requesting Certain Rulings from the Court, at 3.

Put simply, Attorney Carroll stated on the record and in his filings that November 9th was an appropriate date for the hearing, and the Special Master adopted that recommendation. This hearing date has been established and consistently reiterated in the Special Master's orders, and Notices to Attend served on the Commissioners, since the status conference on October 27, 2022, and at no time until now has Attorney Carroll raised the prospect of the Commissioners' official duties interfering with their attendance at a hearing on that date. To the contrary, on the record at the November 4, 2022 status conference in this matter, Attorney Carroll stated that one of the Commissioners would be out of town for a prepaid vacation after the conclusion of their duties on November 8, 2022.

Had the Commissioners requested other accommodations to allow their attendance at the hearing, including but not limited to, convening the hearing in Fulton County, the Special Master would have entertained such requests, as she continually has throughout these proceedings. Instead, Fulton County has repeatedly requested, at the last minute, to be excused from complying with the Special Master's orders, and from attending depositions or the evidentiary hearing.

DOCKET ENTRY

Fulton County seeks a stay of the evidentiary hearing fixed for August 28, 2023, to determine a neutral third-party escrow agent to impound Fulton County's voting systems as directed by the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania in County of Fulton v. Secretary of the Commonwealth, 292 A.3d 974, 1020 (Pa. 2023) (Fulton I). Fulton County asks for a stay based on its filing of a Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the United States Supreme Court (No. 23-96, filed May 27, 2023), challenging the Pennsylvania Supreme Court's decision in Fulton I. However, Fulton County has cited no procedural rule or relevant authority to support its request for stay. Accordingly, the Special Master will proceed as directed by the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania, unless otherwise directed by the Supreme Court of the United States.

- 1. The evidentiary hearing for purposes of the Special Master's appointment of a neutral third-party escrow agent currently fixed for Monday, August 28, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 3001, Third Floor, Pennsylvania Judicial Center, 601 Commonwealth Avenue, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, is hereby RESCHEDULED to begin at 9:00 a.m. on the same date in the same place. If necessary, the hearing shall reconvene on Wednesday, August 30, 2023, at 9:00 a.m., and Thursday, August 31, 2023, at 9:00 a.m., in the same location.
- 2. The parties are directed to serve all Notices to Attend and Subpoenas on their respective witnesses no later than Friday, August 25, 2023, in conformance with the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure. Notices to Attend and Subpoenas served prior to

- 4. Petitioner/Appellees (collectively, Fulton County) shall present its evidence and witness testimony following conclusion of the Secretary's evidence. The parties shall endeavor to expeditiously complete direct and cross examination of Fulton County's witnesses.
- 5. Fulton County is directed to retain the services of a court reporter for the evidentiary hearing. The court reporter shall be prepared for Court to be in session outside of normal Court hours. The court reporter shall provide a rough transcript to the Court and counsel at the conclusion of each day of the hearing and expedite preparation of a transcript following the conclusion of the hearing.

Comment: NOW, August 24, 2023, upon consideration of Thomas J. Carroll, Esquire's (Attorney Carroll) Second Amended Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice, Consent to Designation, and Request to Electronically Receive Notices of Electronic Filing (Second Amended Motion), and Respondent/Appellant's (Secretary) and Intervenor Dominion Voting Systems, LLC's (Dominion) answers in opposition thereto,1 the Second Amended Motion is GRANTED. The Special Master hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Russell Newman, Esquire (Attorney Newman) is admitted pro hac vice to the bar of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under Pennsylvania Bar Admission Rule 301, as co-counsel on behalf of Petitioners/Appellees (collectively, Fulton County) in this matter;
- 2. Attorney Newman shall abide by the rules of this Court including all disciplinary rules;
- 3. Attorney Newman shall immediately notify this Court of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any other court where he may be admitted to practice; and,
- 4. Attorney Carroll, the moving attorney herein, shall continue to be responsible as counsel of record for the conduct of this matter on behalf of Fulton County.
- 1 The Secretary notes, and Dominion asserts, that good cause exists for denying Russell Newman, Esquire (Attorney Newman) to appear pro hac vice in the instant proceedings, citing Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1012.1(e)(1) and (2). The rule, inter alia, provides:
- (e) The court shall grant the motion unless the court, in its discretion, finds good cause for denial.

Note: Good cause may include one or more of the following grounds:

- (1) the admission may be detrimental to the prompt, fair and efficient administration of justice,
- (2) the admission may be detrimental to legitimate interests of the parties to the proceedings other than the client whom the candidate proposes to represent[.]

Pa.R.Civ.P. 1012.1(e)(1), (2). Both the Secretary and Dominion detail and raise concerns regarding Attorney Newman's past litigation history, and question whether his admission would promote the prompt, fair, and efficient administration of justice in the instant proceedings. Dominion also questions Attorney Carroll's fitness to provide the supervision required of a sponsoring attorney as contemplated in Rule 1012.1(d), Pa.R.Civ.P. 1012.1(d), citing the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania's conclusions regarding Attorney Carroll's conduct during the November 2022 contempt hearing held before the Special Master. County of Fulton v. Secretary of the Commonwealth, 292 A.3d 974, 1016 (Pa. 2023) ("Attorney Carroll frequently derailed and delayed the proceedings through a combination of dubious objections, lines of questioning on irrelevant subjects, and legal digressions and conspiratorial hypotheses with little bearing upon the matter at hand.").

Following thoughtful consideration of the Second Amended Motion, and the Secretary's and Dominion's answers in opposition thereto, the Special Master declines to find that good cause exists to deny Attorney Newman pro hac vice admission. The Special Master expects, and will require, Attorney Carroll to vigorously fulfill his duties as sponsor, and Attorney Newman to abide by the rules of this Court.



Comment: NOW, September 15, 2023, following the evidentiary hearing for

purposes of the Special Master's appointment of a neutral third-party escrow agent, as ordered by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court, and in accordance with the foregoing opinion, the Special Master hereby conditionally appoints Pro V&V to serve as escrow agent of the Voting Equipment at issue. Final appointment of Pro V&V as escrow agent will proceed as follows, and is subject to the following conditions:

1. No later than September 29, 2023, the Secretary shall file and serve a Proposed Final Appointment Order executed by Pro V&V1 that includes all terms relating to the escrow arrangement,2 which must

include, without limitation, the following terms, and which may also include any other terms the Secretary and Pro V&V consider to be necessary or appropriate regarding the escrow arrangement3:

a. Access Limitations. Before taking possession of the Voting Equipment, Pro V&V shall designate a laboratory at its facility in which the Voting Equipment shall be stored (Escrow Room). Upon taking possession of the Voting Equipment, Pro V &V shall not permit any access to the Escrow Room except as

follows:
i. Singular Personnel Access. Pro V&V shall restrict access to the Escrow Room to only Michael Walker, who shall retain sole possession of the key or other means of access to the Escrow Room. In the event of Mr. Walker's unavailability, Pro V&V may file a motion with the Court proposing to substitute another Pro V&V employee to temporarily retain sole access, including the dates of the proposed substituted access, to the Escrow Room.
ii. Acts of God; Facilities Emergency. Mr. Walker, or another Pro V&V Employee designated pursuant to Paragraph 1(a)(i) above, may enter the Escrow Room to

respond to acts of God, leaks, fires, or other emergency conditions that require immediate access in order to preserve the Voting Equipment.

iii. Election Assistance Commission Site Visits. Pro V&V may continue to allow EAC personnel to enter its facility as required for accreditation or audit purposes, but Pro

V&V shall not permit EAC personnel to enter the Escrow Room without prior order of Court.

iv. Emergency Notification to Court. If access to the Escrow Room must be granted pursuant to Paragraphs 1(a)(ii) or 1(a)(iii) of this Order, or in a manner not contemplated in this Order, Pro V&V shall immediately notify the Court of such access or impending access via email to CCFCEscrow@pacourts.us copying all counsel of record in this matter, and shall then promptly file a formal motion with the Court explaining the same.

b. Monitoring. Before taking possession of the Voting Equipment, Pro V&V shall install a surveillance or security camera in the Escrow Room (Camera). Once the Voting Equipment is moved to the Escrow Room, Pro V&V shall maintain the Camera in a functional state and trained on the Voting Equipment and its

Comment: NOW, June 11, 2024, upon consideration of Intervenor Dominion Voting Systems, Inc.'s (Dominion) Application for Renewal of the Special Master's Injunction Order, or, in the Alternative, a Protective Order (Application) and Petitioners' (collectively, Fulton County or the County) Response thereto, the Application is GRANTED to the extent it seeks injunctive relief, and the Court hereby ORDERS as follows:

Fulton County and their counsel1 are hereby ENJOINED from disseminating, or allowing third parties to access, any of the evidence or information in the County's possession that formed the basis for the February 19, 2021 Wake TSI Report, the September 15, 2022 Speckin Forensics Report, or any other evidence obtained in any unauthorized inspection of the Voting Equipment,2 as that term is defined in the accompanying Opinion (together with the Confidential Information, the Disputed Information). This injunction will not operate to prohibit disclosure of the Disputed information if the disclosure is:

- 1. ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction; or
- 2. conducted in conformity with the Dominion Lease Agreement; or
- 3. a disclosure only to the County's counsel, experts, agents, or representatives duly retained in the course of litigation to which the County is a party for use in that litigation, and is subject to a written agreement between the County and the person to whom disclosure is made that requires the ongoing confidentiality of the Disputed Information in conformity with the Dominion Lease Agreement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the County or its attorneys violate this Order by releasing, leaking, or otherwise disclosing the Disputed Information to a third party, or by causing or permitting the same actions through the use of an agent, such entity or person shall be subject to sanctions for contempt.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court will retain jurisdiction over all entities and persons subject to this Order to the extent necessary to enforce any obligations arising hereunder or to impose sanctions for any contempt thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary's oral request for an accounting or other description of the County's possession and use of the Disputed Information, made on the record at the hearing on the Application and in which Dominion joined, (see 5/28/24 Tr. at 18, 21, 27), is DENIED without prejudice to request such relief by written application in this Court should a party believe such relief is necessary.

- 1 As used in this Order, the County's counsel shall include all counsel who have at any time entered an appearance for the County in this matter and all attorneys who have in fact represented the County at any time in connection with this matter, including, without limitation, Michigan attorney Stefanie Lambert.
- 2 Capitalized terms used in this Order carry the definitions set forth in the accompanying Opinion, to the extent they are not otherwise defined in this Order.
