In order for appellate proceedings to be stayed, Appellees must 1) make a substantial case on the merits of the appeal, 2) demonstrate that without the requested relief the applicant will suffer substantial injury, 3) a stay will not substantially harm other interested parties in the proceedings, and 4) a stay will not adversely affect the public interest. Pa. Pub. Util. Comm'n v. Process Gas Consumers Grp., 467 A.2d 805 (Pa. 1983) (Process Gas). An applicant for a stay must make a strong showing on each of the above criteria. Id. In the Application, Appellees base their request for a stay solely on the benefit such a stay would have on judicial economy and fail to assert that they would suffer substantial injury absent a stay. Not only does the Court reject the assertion that such a stay would produce significant benefits to judicial economy, the Court finds that a stay of this appeal would unnecessarily delay this Court's decision on the merits of Appellant's appeal and any final resolution of its claims before the trial court, if such proceedings are required to resume. As such, the Application is denied, and the Prothonotary is directed to list this matter for argument before the Court en banc following completion of the parties' briefing, unless otherwise directed.
