Order Granting Petitioner's Emergency Application for Extraordinary Relief

Consistent with the process established in Mellow v. Mitchell, 607 A.2d 204 (Pa. 1992), it is hereby ORDERED:

- 1. The consolidated actions docketed in the Commonwealth Court at Nos. 464 M.D. 2021 and 465 M.D. 2021 shall remain consolidated for all purposes in this Court.
- 2. The Honorable Patricia A. McCullough, a jurist on the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania who currently is presiding over the consolidated actions below, is designated to serve as a Special Master.
- 3. The proceedings occurring in the Commonwealth Court prior to the issuance of this Order, and the filings submitted to that court at its direction in furtherance of those proceedings, shall be considered part of the Special Master's record.
- 4. The Special Master shall file with this Court on or before February 7, 2022, a report containing proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting her recommendation of a redistricting plan from those submitted to the Special Master, along with a proposed revision to the 2022 election schedule/calendar.
- 5. On or before February 14, 2022, any Party or Amicus Participant previously designated by the court below may file with this Court exceptions to the Special Master's report along with a brief in support thereof. This Court will hold oral argument on these exceptions in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania on February 18, 2022, beginning at 9:30 a.m.

The stay issued by this Court on January 31, 2022, is hereby LIFTED. The Gressman Petitioners' Request for Clarification is DISMISSED AS MOOT.

AND NOW, this 23rd day of February, 2022, this Court, following full deliberation and consideration, hereby orders as follows:

First, the Pennsylvania primary and general elections for seats in the United States House of Representatives commencing in the year 2022 shall be conducted in accordance with the "Carter Plan" submitted in the record before the Special Master and as described by 2020 Census block equivalency (denominated the "Carter Plan - Block Assignments") and ESRI shape files (denominated "Carter Plan - Shape Files") uploaded to this Court's website at https://www.pacourts.us/2022-redistricting-opinions. The Carter Plan, in its constituent parts, is hereby made part of this Order, and is hereby ADOPTED as the division of this Commonwealth into seventeen congressional districts, unless and until the same shall be lawfully changed. For reference, images of the Carter Plan, submitted to the Court, are attached at Appendix A, and are available at the above website.

Second, Executive Respondents together with the General Assembly's Legislative Data Processing Center (LDPC), shall prepare textual language that describes the Carter Plan and submit the same to the Secretary of the Commonwealth without delay. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall thereafter file with this Court's Prothonotary a certification of compliance of the preparation of the textual description of the Carter Plan, along with a copy of the textual description.

Third, Respondent Secretary of the Commonwealth shall, without delay, following the preparation of the textual description of the Carter Plan, publish notice of the Congressional Districts in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

Fourth, this Court's February 9, 2022 order, that temporarily suspended the General Primary Election calendar, is VACATED. To provide for an orderly election process, the schedule for the primary election to be held May 17, 2022, for the election of Representatives to the United States Congress and statewide elections is MODIFIED only in the following respects:

First day to circulate and file nomination petitions

Last day to circulate and file nomination petitions

February 25, 2022

March 15, 2022

March 16, 2022

Deadline to file objections to nomination petitions

March 22, 2022

Last day that may be fixed by the Commonwealth Court for hearing on objections that have been filed to nomination petitions March 25, 2022

Last day for the Commonwealth Court to render decisions in cases involving objections to nomination petitions March 29. 2022

Last day for the County Boards of Elections to send remote military-overseas absentee ballots. See 25 Pa.C.S. §3508; 52 U.S.C. §20302(a)(8)(A) April 2, 2022

In all other respects, the dates under the 2022 General Election Primary calendar for Congressional and statewide offices are not modified by this Order. Along these lines, it is NOTED that, with respect to Congressional and statewide offices, the appeal period set forth in Rule of Appellate Procedure 903(c)(1)(ii) (relating to appeals arising under the Election Code) remains in effect. This schedule shall be implemented by the Secretary of the Commonwealth and all election officers within the Commonwealth in accordance with this Court's Order. By separate Order, this Court has temporarily suspended the General Primary Election calendar relative to seats in the Pennsylvania General Assembly. See In re Petitions for Review Challenging the Final 2021 Legislative Reapportionment Plan, 569 Judicial Administration docket (order dated February 23, 2022).

Fifth, should there be any congressional vacancies existing now or occurring after the entry of this Order, but prior to the commencement of the terms of the members to be elected in the General Election of 2022, the districts prescribed in the Remedial Plan adopted by this Court by Order dated February 19, 2018, shall control.

Sixth, the Secretary of the Commonwealth is directed to notify this Court by 4:00 p.m. on February 25, 2022, should it foresee any technical issues concerning the implementation of the Carter Plan.

AND NOW, this 2nd day of March, 2022, presently before this Court are an Application for "Clarification" filed by the Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth and the Director for the Pennsylvania Bureau of Election Services and Notaries (Respondents), an Application for Intervention filed by the Delaware County Board of Elections (Delaware County), and Respondents' subsequent Reply to the Application for Intervention. In their filings, Respondents seek modification of the Primary Election calendar for state party committees (State Committees) and local party committees a/k/a precinct committees (Local Committees), which neither Respondents nor this Court have previously addressed.

Upon consideration of Respondents' Application and Delaware County's response, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The period for circulating and filing nomination petitions for Local Committees shall be aligned for all purposes with the period for circulating and filing nomination petitions by candidates for Congressional and statewide offices. Accordingly, the period for circulating nomination petitions for Local Committees shall commence immediately, and nomination petitions for Local Committees shall be filed on or before March 15, 2022.
- 2. The period for circulating and filing nomination petitions for State Committees shall be aligned for all purposes with the period for circulating and filing nomination petitions for seats in the Pennsylvania General Assembly, which will be set by further Order of this Court subsequent to its adjudication of the appellate challenges to the Final Plan of the Legislative Reapportionment Commission.
- 3. The Application for Intervention filed by Delaware County is GRANTED for the limited purpose of permitting Delaware County to present its counterargument to Respondents' Application for "Clarification."
