On December 30, 2024, the Pennsylvania Independent Petroleum Producers Association, the Pennsylvania Independent Oil and Gas Association, and the Pennsylvania Grade Crude Oil Coalition (together, Association Intervenors) filed an answer stating that</p> <p>although the Supreme Court denied proposed Legislator Intervenors' Application to Expedite Briefing and Argument, it nevertheless established a briefing schedule and expressly stated the denial was "without prejudice to seek a stay" of this action.
