Comment: consideration of the Joint Stipulation of the parties and the credible testimony of the witnesses presented during the hearing as well as the documentary evidence, it is hereby ORDERED and DIRECTED as follows:

- 1. The parties having agreed and stipulated to the existence of the conditions set forth in Section 702(d)(l), (d)(2), and (d)(3) of Act 47, and as established by the record evidence, this Court finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that the following conditions apply and are established:
- a. Thirty (30) days have elapsed from the date of the Governor's Declaration of Fiscal Emergency on April 13, 2020, in satisfaction of Section 702(d)(1) of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.702(d)(1);
- b. There has been a failure by the Chester City Council, the governing body of the City of Chester, to adopt an ordinance under Section 607 of Act 47 in satisfaction of Section 702(d)(2)(i) of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.702(d)(2)(i); and
- c. A fiscal emergency under Section 602(a) of Act 47, 53 P.S. § 11701.602(a), continues to exist in the City of Chester in satisfaction of Section 702(d)(3) of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.702(d)(3).
- 2. The Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development's (DCED) Petition for Appointment of Receiver for the City of Chester (City) is hereby GRANTED. The City is hereby DECLARED to be in receivership pursuant to Section 702(e)(2) of Act 4 7, 53 P.S. § 11701. 702(e)(2).
- 3. Michael Doweary is found qualified under Section 705(b) of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.705(b), has no known disqualifying conflicts of interest or bias, and is hereby APPOINTED to be the Receiver for the City for a period not to exceed two years, subject to extension under Section 710(b) of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.710(b).
- 4. The Receiver is ordered to develop a recovery plan within 30 days of the date of this Order under Section 703 of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.703 (Recovery Plan), and submit the Recovery Plan to this Court, the Secretary for DCED, the Chester City Council, and the Mayor of Chester.
- 5. The Receiver is required and empowered to implement the Emergency Action Plan (EAP) developed by the Secretary of DCED under Section 602 of Act 47, 53 P.S. § 11701.602, until a recovery plan developed by the Receiver is approved by this Court pursuant to Section 703 of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.703.
- 6. During the fiscal emergency, the Chester City Council, including the Mayor, shall continue to carry out its duties, including duties relating to the City's budget, subject to and consistent with the provisions of the EAP, any Recovery Plan developed by the Receiver and approved by this Court, and Chapter 7 of Act 4 7.

(Parties) as to the issues stated in the December 16 Order, it is hereby ORDERED:

The Receiver has the power to implement the Recovery Plan confirmed by the Court (Plan) and the authority to require compliance by City officials, (elected and appointed) with the "acts set forth in the [Plan]." 53 P.S. §II 701.704(a)(1). Such acts include those specified in WF03 in the Plan, and set forth in the first issue, except with regard to the Chief Operating Officer (COO). Moreover, the Plan requires the Receiver to consult with Council before making such decisions. While not bound by Council's advice on WF03, consultation here implies measured consideration of Council recommendations in good faith, accounting for the Council's expertise and knowledge of City staff and historical personnel needs . The Receiver's authority here described as to (I)(a), (b) and (c) is CONFIRMED.

As to the creation of a new position (COO) that alters the managerial structure and undertakes a supervisory role over all staff, such that the described duties of the COO overlap with the duties of the Mayor as outlined in Article III of the Home Rule Charter, that act is not specifically set forth in the Plan. Thus, to the extent the duties of the position of COO overlap with and seem to supplant the duties conferred on the Mayor, the Court does not construe the current Plan to allow the creation of the COO position holding the duties currently described.

Until a modification is submitted and approved, the Parties are encouraged to continue their collaborative efforts to resolve the managerial role of the COO to enable continuation of vital and necessary services.

As the modification shall be filed within a matter of weeks (by or before February 8, 2021), this Court HOLDS IN ABEYANCE a decision as to the second issue (i.e., that the proposed implementation of the Plan undermines the City's provision of vital and necessary services), until a hearing is held on the modification.

The Parties are encouraged to continue collaborating on the proposed budget, incorporating Receiver's proposed reorganization as authorized by the Plan, in accordance with their good faith negotiations to date.

This Order is without prejudice to the Parties' ability to avail themselves of any legal remedies under Act 4 7 or otherwise.

also submitted three exhibits, the Amended and Restated Master Asset Management Agreement (Agreement) dated September 5, 2018 (Ex. 1), the summary of PFS expenditures under the Agreement to date (Ex. 2), and Receiver's Proposed Plan (Ex. 3). The Court admitted Exhibits 1 and 2; Exhibit 3 is already filed of record.

PFS Counsel argued the Proposed Plan alters the 2020 Plan in a material fashion in that it indicates the Receiver's intent to terminate the Agreement. See Proposed Plan at 85-88. PFS demonstrated that the Proposed Plan sets forth a different approach to the parking asset monetization issue than that in the 2020 Plan, and handling of same by the Receiver. Because Receiver's proposed termination of the Agreement represents a change between the 2020 Plan and the Proposed Plan that, if effectuated, has the potential to alter a "legally enforceable interest" of PFS, PFS has grounds to intervene. Pa.R.C.P. No. 2327(4).3

Additionally, PFS Counsel represented that PFS recognizes it is held to the clear and convincing evidentiary burden set forth in Section 703(d) of Act 47, to prove its allegation that the parking asset aspect of the Proposed Plan is arbitrary in that the Receiver did not consider the liabilities attendant to litigating the contract dispute, including the potential financial impact on the City of terminating the Agreement.

AND FURTHER, in granting the Application, the Court does not opine as to the legality of the Agreement, and that issue is outside the confines of the intervention and the May 5, 2021 hearing on the Proposed Plan.

3 The Court is aware that a contract dispute involving the Agreement is pending in the Delaware County Court of Common Pleas, No. 2019-000011. That action is separate from the Act 47 Plan confirmation proceedings under Section 703 of Act 47, 53 P.S. §11701.703; as such, this Court makes no opinion as to the contract claims or the propriety of the Receiver's proposed role in same.

Comment: AND NOW, this 4th day of January, 2023, following a pre-hearing conference with counsel for Michael T. Doweary, in his capacity as Receiver for the City of Chester (Receiver), the City of Chester, and the Stormwater Authority of the City of Chester (Stormwater Authority), in advance of the hearing scheduled to begin on Monday, January 9, 2023 on Receiver's Modification of Amended Recovery Plan (Plan Modification), the Court hereby ORDERS as follows:

- (1) The parties shall be precluded from presenting testimony or evidence as to Receiver's qualifications and experience to serve as an appointed receiver at the Plan Modification hearing. Governor Tom Wolf nominated Receiver to oversee the City of Chester's fiscal recovery pursuant the Municipalities Financial Recovery Act, Act of July 10, 1987, P.L. 246, No. 47, as amended, 53 P.S. § 11701.101-11701.712 (Act 47), in April 2020, and this Court confirmed Receiver's appointment in June 2020. Any challenges to Receiver's qualifications and experience to serve as an Act 47 receiver could have and should have been raised at that time, not two-and-one-half years later. To the extent such challenges were not raised at that time, they are now waived.
- (2) In considering the factual and legal issues presented by Receiver's Plan Modification and the City of Chester's objections thereto, the Court will apply the standard of review set forth in Section 703(e) of Act 47, which states that "[t]he [C]ourt shall confirm the modification within 60 days of receipt of notification of the modification unless it finds clear and convincing evidence that the recovery plan as modified is arbitrary, capricious or wholly inadequate to alleviate the fiscal emergency in the distressed municipality." 53 P.S. § 11701.703(e) (emphasis added).
- (3) As discussed during the pre-hearing conference, the Court will not address or receive evidence on Receiver's proposed initiatives relating to the Stormwater Authority at the Plan Modification hearing, nor will it address or receive evidence on the outstanding "Application for an Order Determining that the City is Authorized to Pay Attorney Fees in Excess of \$7,500" filed by the City of Chester on September 2, 2022.

(a) City Council shall rescind Resolution No. 152-2023, which authorized the payment of all counsel fees to the law firm of Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney, P.C. (Buchanan), at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

(b) Following two WebEx video conferences with the Court, and at the Court's direction, the parties have proposed differing figures in an attempt to settle the dispute over the City's outstanding legal fees, which has been ongoing since 2022. Receiver now proposes \$118,488.14; the City now 2

proposes \$222,000. Both figures are less than the actual amount of the City's outstanding legal fees. The City has further indicated in its supplemental brief that it would be agreeable to splitting the difference between the two figures, which is \$170,244.07. Receiver does not agree to this proposed compromise figure.

While Receiver has the authority to direct litigation and expert selection pursuant to the Amended Recovery Plan and the Emergency Action Plan, the Court disagrees with Receiver that the City's hiring of outside special counsel to defend against Receiver's petitions, particularly where the City Solicitor was a testifying witness in those proceedings, was a purely "discretionary" expense. The Court recognizes that Buchanan's hourly rate was significantly higher than the hourly rate charged by Receiver's counsel. However, both the City and Buchanan have now agreed to accept an even lower fee amount to resolve the present dispute, which the Court finds reasonable and justified under the circumstances.1

Accordingly, the Court directs that the City shall pay the sum of \$170,244.07 to Buchanan to satisfy its outstanding legal fees relating to this matter no later than Friday, December 29th, 2023.

- (c) Receiver's request that City Council rescind Resolution No. 151-2023, which waived all City fees and other financial obligations for the Chester Stormwater Authority Veteran's Park Regional Stormwater Facility, is now moot, because City Council rescinded Resolution No. 151-2023 in October 2023.
- 1 However, the Court cautions that, going forward, it will not condone the City's retention of any special counsel who charges such a high hourly rate, given the City's dire financial condition.
- (2) Receiver's Application for Sanctions and Civil Contempt, filed on September 5, 2023, is hereby DENIED. The Court concludes that City Council's passage of the resolutions at issue was not so obdurate, vexatious, or arbitrary as to justify the imposition of sanctions.
- (3) The City's "Application for an Order Determining the City is Authorized to Pay Attorney Fees Related to the Receiver's Petition for Writ of Mandamus," filed on September 2, 2022, is hereby DISMISSED AS MOOT.
